Welcome to our 19th annual – and second virtual – Savor the Season!

Whether this is your first or nineteenth time attending *Savor* (there are a few of you!), please know you play a critical role in our community's health and recovery. *Thank you.* 

When we first gathered virtually last year, Alameda County Community Food Bank had evolved more in 6

months than any point in the previous 35 years. Little did we know that we were just hitting our stride. Today's ACCFB is dramatically different from the organization serving this community in February 2020:

- We now provide enough food for nearly 50 million meals annually. The year before COVID, we provided 28 million meals. This is one reason ACCFB is undergoing its largest warehouse expansion in a decade.
- We partner with 420+ organizations to provide food across the county. Prior to the pandemic, it was fewer than 370.
- Emergency programs like contactless drive-through distributions and home delivery are now a permanent part of our mission. The Oakland drive-through still helps more than II,000 people every week.

The fact we're hosting Savor virtually again speaks to the profound and ongoing impact of the pandemic on food security for our entire community – particularly children, adults, and seniors depending on us.

Simply put: We're so grateful for your compassion, partnership, and support.

Today is all about impact ... while having a bit of fun. Please give as generously as you can. Friendly competition is encouraged and makes an enormous difference in thousands of our lives. Plus, your generosity will go further with some exciting opportunities to be announced in our broadcast.
