

Volunteer COVID-19 Prevention and Safety Policy (11/1)

As an essential services provider, ACCFB takes our responsibility for the health and safety of staff, volunteers, and community members very seriously. Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, we have closely followed public health guidance and taken a strong approach to implement preventive measures. Moving forward together into the next phase of our pandemic response, we are requiring volunteers at all ACCFB facilities (7900 Edgewater Drive and the Oakport Street drive-thru pantry) to provide either proof of vaccination or documentation that they have tested negative for COVID-19 within 72 hours of the start of their shift.

This policy is effective Nov. 1, 2021 until further notice.

This policy ensures ACCFB can fulfill its mission by minimizing the potential for a closure due to isolation and quarantine requirements.

All volunteers, regardless of vaccine status, are still required to wear masks and practice social distancing.

Vaccinated Volunteers

You are fully vaccinated two weeks after receiving a second dose of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccines or three weeks after the single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.

Acceptable proof of vaccination status:

- A CDC vaccination card that shows the dates and vaccine type and lot number
- A copy of the digital vaccination records obtained from the CA Department of Public health (<https://myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov>)
- A letter from your licensed healthcare provider providing the dates and vaccine type you received

Unvaccinated Volunteers

We understand there are many reasons people may not be eligible or chose not to take a vaccine. Unvaccinated volunteers must provide test results demonstrating they are negative for the COVID-19 virus. The test must have been performed within 72 hours of your volunteer shift.

Acceptable proof of a negative test result:

ACCFB will adhere to the FDA-recommended molecular testing methods (PCR) and cannot accept over-the-counter, self-administered, or rapid antigen tests.

Privacy Disclosure:

ACCFB does not retain copies of volunteer vaccine or test records. Volunteers may notify the Volunteer Manager (volunteer@acfb.org) if they prefer not to have us record the date of vaccination verification, but you will be asked to provide documentation each time you volunteer.
